# Human and physical features **Key Vocabulary Human features** Human features are things that have been built by people. Valley - A ditch in the Earth's surface. **Beach** – A strip of land that borders an Physical features Valleys usually lie between hills or ocean, river or lake. Physical features are natural things mountains. that would be there even if people were not. **Cliff** - A tall, steep wall of rock. Hill - A piece of land that rises higher than everything surrounding it. A waterfall is a physical feature.

Mountain - An area of land that is much higher than the land surrounding it.

Vegetation - An area with a specific type or types of plants.
